* As long as players take part in bingo draws in a jackpot cycle of the «Wallstreet» online bingo product <u>without</u> <u>interruption</u>, the lowest card price paid by the player is used, regardless of the current jackpot amount. However, if a jackpot cycle draw is missed, the card price at the current price level must be paid the next time the player participates in the same jackpot cycle.

Allocation to Bingo pot: Allocation to jackpot price and booster fund: 52% of the stake for a draw 23% of the stake for a draw

- If the amount in the booster fund prior to the draw is at least ten times the starting jackpot, 23% of the stakes for the draw will be added to the jackpot prize and 0% to the booster fund.
- If the amount in the booster fund prior to the draw is less than ten times the starting jackpot

of the stakes for the draw will be added to the jackpot price. The difference between 23% and the share of the stakes for the draw allocated to the jackpot price will be allocated to the booster fund.
